

REQUEST OF PROPOSALS
FROM PLUMBING CONTRACTORS
TO ASSIST
THE OPERATIONS OF THE HOUSING AUTHORITY OF PLAINFIELD

The Housing Authority of Plainfield is requesting proposals from qualified and licensed plumbing contractors who have registered with the State of New Jersey to assist the Authority to replace and repair existing plumbing -related equipment and respond to emergency services at Joanne Hollis gardens and Richmond towers. The scope of services is outlined in the application package to be completed by contractors.

The annual services shall not exceed \$80,000 per year. Please refer to the scope of services inside the proposal application package.

Interested companies shall submit license, current certificate of insurance with workers compensation and three work-related references to be included in the proposal package.

The service tickets/reports shall be forwarded to the Authority indicating time, date and reason for the services calls after completion of each task.

One original and two copies of the proposal are required to be delivered to the Administration Office located at 510 East Front Street, Plainfield, New Jersey on or before 11:00 a.m., February 11, 2026. All proposals are required to comply with the requirement of PL. 1975C.127 affirmative action and equal employment laws in accordance with the applicable state and federal regulations.
